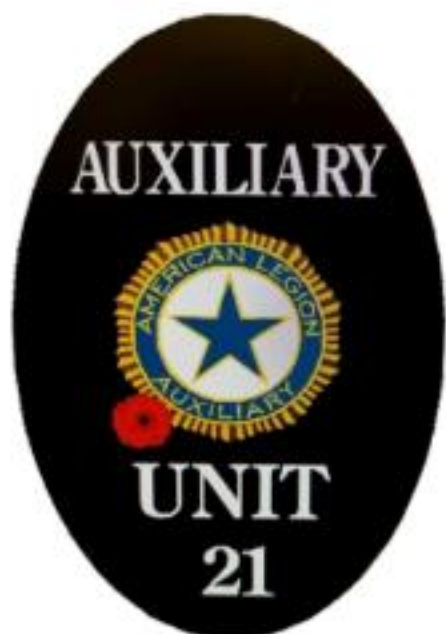

UNIT 21 AUXILIARY MEMBERSHIP

As I mentioned last month, we are now at the beginning of the 2027 Auxiliary year and are working on a new year of membership. Thank you to those who have already paid their 2027 dues. Membership dues for 2027 are **\$40.00 for senior members** (age 18 and over) - and **Junior dues** (birth through age 17) **are only \$10.00**. The National office doesn't send out dues notices until September, but you don't need to wait for a renewal notice. Just send your check payable to ALA Unit 21 to me at 1332 11th Avenue North, Moorhead, MN 56560-1614 and I will send your new membership card. If I can get your dues submitted to the National office by the first week in August, they will not need to send you a renewal notice. Since they have nearly a million renewals to get processed, any savings in postage helps. Please remember, the National office does not send dues notices for junior members. If you are paying for a junior member, just add \$10.00 to your check for each junior member you are paying for, add a note indicating their name(s) and I will send their card(s) to you.

Also, those who pay their 2027 dues on or before Veteran's Day (November 11) will have their membership card marked with an early bird stamp which is good for one free drink at the Moorhead Legion. If you pay your dues online, your card comes from the National office, but you can still get an EARLY BIRD stamp – just bring your card to an Auxiliary meeting to get it stamped or give me a call and I will send one out to you. Sooooo – be an Early Bird and help get our 2027 membership year off to a great start!

Our membership for 2026 exceeded our assigned goal, and we received awards at the Department Convention a couple weeks ago. Let's do it again for 2027.

Hello,

The summer has gone fast which gears us up for fall and our 3rd annual Stand Down which will take place on 9/10/2026, at the Broadway Square from 10am-2pm. There will be over 35 service booths, a free pulled pork meal and music. Veterans are invited to attend with their families as there will be many giveaways and donated items to assist our homeless veterans. Free haircuts will be offered, flu shots and eye exams. The 2026 Cass & Clay Stand Down will provide direct assistance and resource connection services to approximately 350 attendees, including an estimated 185 veterans. Based on prior event data and Community Resource and Referral Center (CRRC) screening, approximately 50-75 veterans are expected to meet the definition of homelessness or at-risk of homelessness and will be eligible for grant-funded items and services at the event. We hope to see you all there!

Food Drive in the FM Area –

AMVETS Fargo, the Fargo American Legion, the Fargo and West Fargo VFWs, Moorhead American Legion, the DAV, and their respective Auxiliaries are all teaming up to fill the shelves at the Great Plains Food Bank. 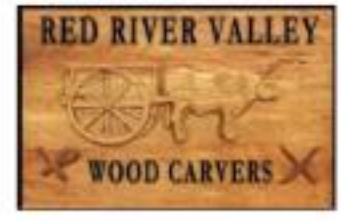
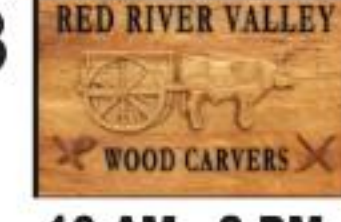
