FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD **FARGO VA NATIONAL CEMETERY**



THE FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD HAS BEEN SERVING THE FARGO VETERANS NATIONAL CEMETERY SINCE IT'S DEDICATION ON 7 SEPTEMBER 2019.

It is hard to believe that it has been four years since we started doing internment/burials at the Fargo National Cemetery. The figures for this month's newsletter are from 13 October 2019 to 30 April 2024.

What do you get when you cross poison ivy with a 4-leaf clover?

There are 221 urns in the Columbarium, 488 urns in the ground, 25 caskets in the private vaults, 215 caskets in the Government vaults, and 2 plaques on the Memorial Wall, FOR A TOTAL OF 953 INTERNMENTS/BURIALS AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY. THIS INCLUDES 759 VETERANS AND 194 SPOUSES FOR A TOTAL OF 953. AND THERE ARE 110 COUPLES INTERRED/BURIED AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERIES.

The breakdown per branch of service is as follows: Army—395, Navy – 150, US Marine Corps—61, US Air Force - 149, ARMY/AF—4, and Spouses – 194, for a total of 953 internments/burials.

Our yearly volunteer hours are – 2019 = 966, 2020 = 2,072, 2021 = 3,373, 2022 = 2,798, 2023 = 2,557 – 2024 = 252. Since 13 October 2019 thru 30 APRIL 2024, we have accumulated 12,517 donated volunteer hours.

WE HAVE A TOTAL OF 16 UNCLAIMED VETERANS BURIED AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY. FROM 20 OCTOBER 2020 THRU 31 DECEMBER 2023, WE HAD 11 UNCLAIMED. WE HAVE RECEIVED 5 UNCLAIMED SO FAR IN 2024, FOR A TOTAL OF 16 UNCLAIMED VETERANS.

THERE HAVE BEEN A NUMBER OF VETERAN INTERNMENTS/BURIALS IN THE AREA - LOCAL CHURCHES AND COMMUNITY CEMETERIES.

The Fargo Memorial Honor Guard has performed Military Honors in all types of weather. The FM Honor Guard WILL NEVER cancel an Internment of a Veteran because of bad weather. The family has to make that decision.
