2027 Membership Renewals

BE AN "EARLY BIRD"

As of August 22, 325 members have renewed their 2027 dues—thank you. That puts us exactly where we were at this time last year. We have already met Nationals' first target of 50% by September 10, and we need just 25 more renewals to reach 55% by October 14.

To encourage early renewals, I am offering an incentive. Everyone who renews by Veterans Day will be entered in a drawing for \$100. Last year, we had 426 renewals by Veterans Day. I will add a second \$100 prize if we reach 400 renewals by then, and another \$100 prize if we reach 500. Our Post 21 goal this year is 600 renewals. The drawing will be held on November 12, after the mail arrives, and will include payments postmarked by November 11.

You may renew by mail through USPS or online. Online renewal is the fastest way to renew your 2027 membership: visit www.legion.org/renew and follow the instructions. Once you renew online, the Post will be notified, and I will mail your 2027 membership card within a few days.

Membership is not just something for the Membership Chairman to do – it involves every member, starting with renewing your own membership on an annual basis and inviting eligible relatives and friends to join our organization. You did an excellent job for 2026 which resulted in our Unit exceeding our assigned membership goal and receiving awards at the Department Convention. Now it's time to work on a new year. As you can see from the above, it's starting out very well with seven new members, and, as I write this article, we already have the second highest percentage in our District for 2027 renewals turned in. This is fantastic – let's keep it going!

If you are receiving this newsletter, anyone in your immediate family is very likely eligible for membership in the American Legion Auxiliary. In general, eligibility involves spouses, mothers, grandmothers, sisters and granddaughters of men and women who served in the Armed Forces from April 6, 1917 through November 11, 1918, and any time after December 7, 1941. **If the veteran you choose for eligibility is still living, they must be a current member of an American Legion Post.** A female veteran is eligible for Auxiliary membership based on her own service, and it's not required that she be a member of the American Legion. However, if any of her family members wish to join the Auxiliary listing her for their eligibility, she would have to be an American Legion member.

There are several membership awards available to individual Auxiliary members on the Department (State) and National levels of our organization: 1) The Minnesota member who recruits the most new members will receive one year paid membership; 2) Recruit/Rejoin 10 – a member who recruits any combination of junior or senior members by 6/4/2027 will receive a special gift selected by the National Membership Chairman; and 3) Family 3 – a member who recruits 3 New Legion Members, 3 New Auxiliary Members and 3 new SAL members will receive a special gift selected by the National President. Lori Ishaug received a nice gift for the Recruit/Rejoin 10 award for 2026 and is well on her way to earning another one this year. Congratulations and thank you Lori.

Let's have another winning membership year as we work to make life a little better for our veterans who have given so much to make life better for all of us.

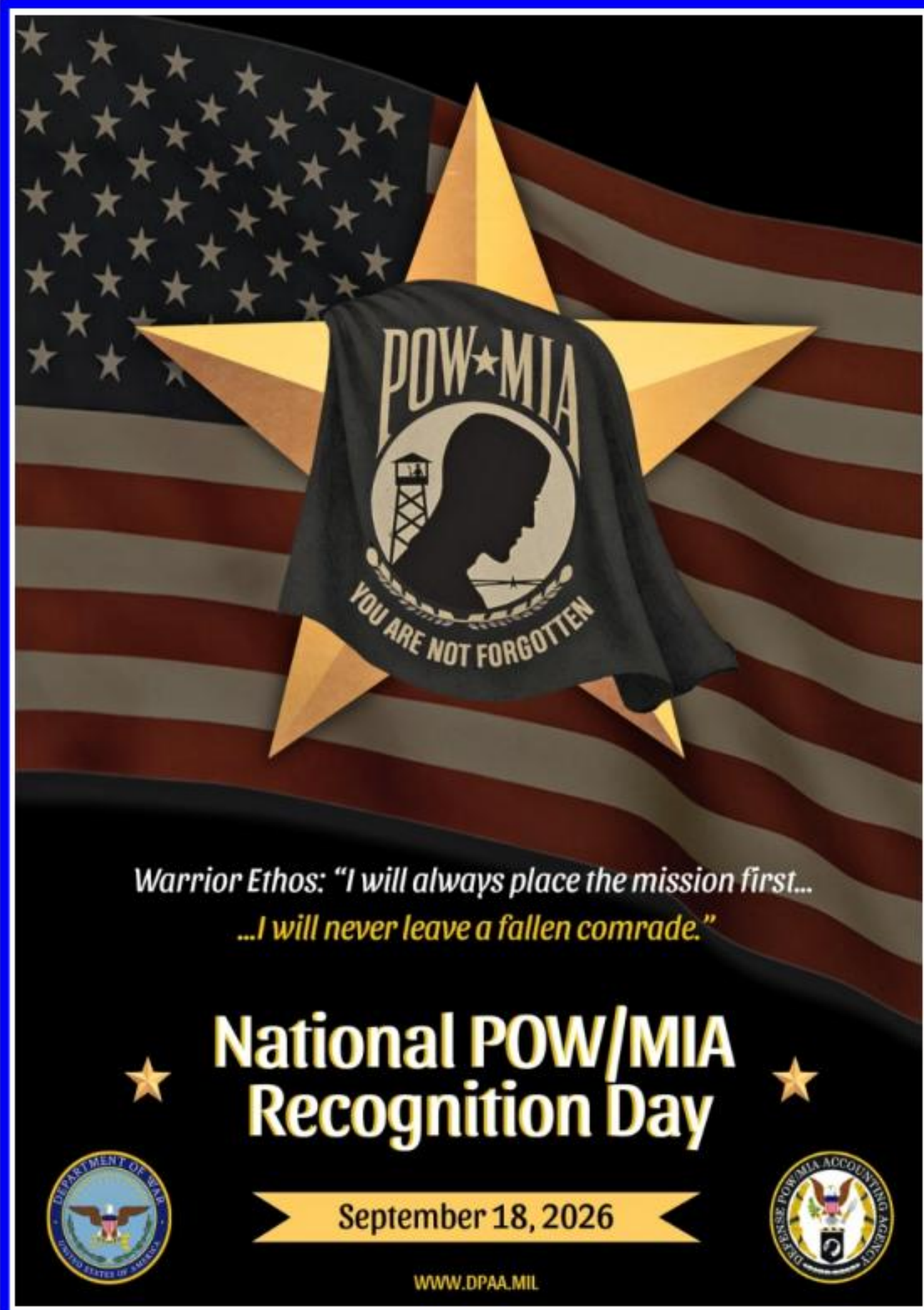


Legion Expansion Project
