
UNIT 21 AUXILIARY MEMBERSHIP



ND and MN winters are no joke — but there are many ways to stay warm, connected, and have some fun along the way.

Layer clothing — moisture-wicking base layers make a huge difference.

If you're struggling to heat your home, contact your county VSO — there are programs that can help.

Try Something Fun This Season

Winter can be long, but it doesn't have to be lonely or boring. Consider:

Outdoor activities like ice fishing, snowshoeing, or cross-country skiing

Visiting local VA recreation therapy events

Joining a veteran coffee group or winter wellness challenge — Fargo Air Museum for ex.

Checking out indoor attractions — museums, fitness centers, gyms, or bowling

Exploring veteran-run businesses and community events

Remember, staying active is good for both your body and your mental health.

2026 COLA Increase: What Veterans Need to Know

Each year, VA disability compensation increases to keep pace with the rising cost of living.

For 2026, veterans will see a COLA increase, meaning:

Your monthly service-connected disability payments will go up, starting with the January payment.

Surviving spouses and dependents receiving VA benefits will also receive this increase.

No action is required — VA automatically adjusts the amount.

VA Outreach and Homeless Support Team Success

FARGO, N.D. (Valley News Live) - The Fargo VA Health Care System helped 177 homeless veterans find permanent housing in fiscal year 2025, part of a nationwide effort that housed nearly 52,000 veterans. The Department of Veterans Affairs permanently housed 51,936 homeless veterans nationwide, 4,011 more than in 2024. The numbers represent the VA's best national performance since it began tracking individual veterans housed rather than total housing placements in 2022.

Each Town Hall will cover updates for the entire Health Care System and go into detail on our respective Outpatient Clinics.

MATBUS Offers Free Rides for All Veterans

Effective Tuesday, November 11, MATBUS will begin to offer free rides to all veterans, regardless of disability status. Since 2009, the public transit system's fare policy has included free rides for service-connected veterans, a status given to those injured during their military service. Riders showed their eligibility for the free rides by presenting a veteran ID with the "service-connected" designation.

Now, any veteran can ride free on MATBUS fixed routes when they show their veteran ID, and no further verification will be required. This free fare will continue year-round. The change has been welcomed to further support all who served in the United States military. It will also reduce any potential confusion that could occur onboard the bus when only select veterans were included in the policy.



IRA - Individual Retirement Account QCD - Qualified Charitable Contribution

If you have an IRA and are 70½ or older, you can make a transfer from your IRA directly to a qualified charity using a QCD, and it will be tax-free. These transfers are a great way to give to a qualified charity, especially if you do not itemize deductions or file a tax return.

The amount is not reported as income and is not taken as an itemized deduction if you file a tax return. The amounts must be paid directly from your IRA to the qualified charity.

Our American Legion is a qualified charity. If you want to use this method to donate to our American Legion, contact the trustee of your IRA to arrange a direct payment to "American Legion Post 21".

Your holder (trustee) of your IRA or your tax preparer should be able to answer any other questions you have concerning a QCD.
