FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD VA NATIONAL CEMETERY



THE FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD HAS BEEN SERVING THE FARGO VETERANS NATIONAL CEMETERY SINCE It'S DEDICATION ON 7 SEPTEMBER 2019.

For the month of May, we had 25 internments/burials, 13 Urns in LOT #2 (GROUND) AND 8 Urns IN THE – CCA (COLUMN BARIUM), AND 4 CASKETS IN LOT #5.

There are 176 urns in the Columbarium, 387 urns in the ground, 26 caskets in the private vaults, 183 caskets in the Government vaults, and 2 plaques on the Memorial Wall. WE HAVE 617 VETERANS, AND 157 POUSES INTERRED/BURIED AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY, FOR A TOTAL OF 774 INTERNMENTS/BURIALS. THIS INCLUDES THE 82 COUPLES INTERRED/BURIED AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY.

THE breakdown per branch of service: Army – 334, Navy – 124, Marine Corps – 44, US Air Force - 111, USAF - 4, and Spouses – 157, for a total of 774 internments/burials.





Have a Happy and safe 4th of July

Recently, I was at a training session with VSO Curt Cannon and Jen Conklin regarding our positions and new updates. The National Association of County Veterans Service Officers was extremely beneficial, and their big push was the PACT Act, healthcare, and making sure veterans know what they're eligible for after service.

Post-9/11 combat veterans who served between 2001 and 2013 have until Sept. 30 to enroll in Department of Veterans Affairs health care. The date will conclude a one-year "special enrollment period" provided by the PACT Act. This provision of the PACT Act took effect in 2022. The Act's full name is Sergeant First Class Heath Robinson Honoring Our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics. It gave the potential to receive compensation to millions of veterans or their survivors who were exposed to radiation and toxic chemicals while in uniform, going back to the 1960s.

How to Apply for VA Health Care

Veterans may apply for VA health care:

Online at https://www.va.gov/health-care/apply/application/introduction

By calling Curt Cannon or Christopher Deery

By mail. Send VA Form 10-10EZ to Health Eligibility Center, 2957 Clairmont Road, Suite 200, Atlanta, GA 30329. In person at your local VSO office.

Please call Curt Cannon or myself to set up an appointment for a file review. There are many new opportunities for veterans, and with the PACT Act, this opens many appeals and claims for veterans that may not have been eligible in the past. Also, since the Act was enabled last August, over 500,000 claims have been filed, with payments being received by veterans and their families totaling over 1 billion dollars. The director of the National Cemetery was present and spoke to us about the last benefit a veteran would receive which is a proper burial. Only 22% of veterans are using this service. Please come see Curt or I to make arrangements or meet with your local funeral home. Make sure your loved ones know where your DD214 is to begin that process. Veterans only need 1 day of service prior to Sept. 7, 1980. After this date, veterans must have had 24 months of active duty or served the full period of which you were called upon.

Please have a safe holiday and enjoy it. Thank you to all veterans and heroes who fought for our freedoms and continue to do so at home or abroad.


