FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD

VA NATIONAL CEMETERY



THE FARGO MEMORIAL HONOR GUARD HAS BEEN SERVING THE FARGO VETERANS NATIONAL CEMETERY SINCE It's DEDICATION ON 7 SEPTEMBER 2019.

For the month of AUGUST, we had 22 internments/burials, 9 Urns in LOT # 2 (GROUND), 8 Urns IN THE – CCA(COLUMNBARIUM), AND 5 CASKES IN LOT # 5.

What do you get when you cross poison ivy with a 4-leaf clover?

There are 196 urns in the Columbarium, 429 urns in the ground, 26 caskets in the private vaults, 193 caskets in the Government vaults, and 2 plaques on the Memorial Wall, FOR A TOTAL OF 846 INTERNMENTS/BURIALS AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY. THIS INCLUDES 672 VETERANS AND 174 POUSES FOR A TOTAL OF 846. AND THERE ARE 88 COUPLES INTERRED/BURIED AT THE FARGO NATIONAL CEMETERY.

A rash of good Luck.

THE breakdown per branch of service is: Army – 359, Navy – 138, US Marine Corps – 47, US Air Force -124, USAF -4, and Spouses – 174, for a total of 846 internments/burials.

LAST TWO LOCAL CIVIL WAR VETS WILL BE HONORED

Two local men, one from Clay County and the other from Wilkin County will be honored on Saturday, 23 September 2023. Both men have been dead for about 90 years. They are being honored as the last Civil War Veterans to die in their respective counties.

Pvt Horace Easton Davis will be honored in a ceremony at 1:00 PM at Riverside Cemetery in Breckenridge, MN.

Pvt. Joseph Uebersetzig of Barnesville, MN., will be honored in a ceremony at 5:00 PM at the St. Joseph Cemetery, Moorhead, MN.

Fall is Here!

Veterans Service Officer

22 years ago, our lives changed forever, especially mine; where soon after the Twin Tower attacks, I joined the United States Army. I remember being at MEPS on 9/15, swearing in to protect the country I so deeply love. We were under attack, and innocent people were killed, including those first responders, police, firefighters, and heroes that brought down a plane, knowing the cost as it was targeting another key US marker. We were scared, I was scared, but honestly, there was no turning back. Some people ran into the fire that day, and this was our turn. Nothing was ever going to be the same again. 4 years later, my unit, HHC 2-136th CAB, was called upon to go to Iraq with many other Minnesota units to fight for that very freedom. 4,000 soldiers prepared for months of training and became veterans. Two years, we were gone. We all joined for various reasons, but being brought together as a collective body, we knew what had to be done. Protect and defend, lean on those around you for guidance, and finish the mission. I was part of the longest National Guard deployment in US history to Iraq. I was part of a team that remembered each day why we were doing what we were doing so that events like 9/11 would never happen again. The Red Bulls will always have a place in my heart. Those heroes will never be forgotten, too. Patriot Day is every day.

We honored the victims of 9/11 that morning at Davy Memorial Park in Moorhead on the 22nd anniversary of those tragic events. It was a remembrance ceremony, and we want to thank the Veterans who hosted the memorial tribute and to presenter and veteran Tom Krabbenhoft for his moving speech. Thank you.

Color/Honor Guard

Color/Honor Guard Report,

In September, the Honor Guard presented military honors for the following individuals: Alfred Heiberger Jr., US Navy, who served during Vietnam in Japan, Philippines, and Hawaii; and Andrew Garnfor, US Army as a classified carrier and then retired from NDANG in 1994.

The Color Guard was involved in two activities in September. It represented the Post at the September 1, 10:00 AM parade at the Rollag Steam Threshers reunion, along with the FM Legion Riders and the SAL. We then led the Greater Moorhead Days parade, again with assistance from the FM Legion Riders and the SAL.

On September 21, Post 21 received ten refurbished M1 rifles from the CMP. We are in the process of preparing them for use by the Honor Guard. They were delivered in need of proper lubrication and set up for firing blanks. Our current M1s will be returned to the US Army as required by regulations.

For several months, I have been asking for new individuals to join the Honor/Color Guard. I have had no one come forward to Join us in this important duty of honoring our fellow veterans and comforting their survivors. At a full honors ceremony, the rifle detail has M1 Garand rifles that we use to fire three shots each before taps are played, and the flag is folded and provided to the Veteran's family.

The Post provides the uniforms we wear and a stipend of \$30 per event you participate in.

As the Honor/Color Guard Commander, I coordinate with the Honor Guard/Color Guard members to determine who is available for any single event, which normally occurs between 10 AM and 4 PM with an occasional evening event.
